## UC:S19 Papers of Arthur Spencer Loat Farquharson (Fellow 1899-1942)

Arthur Spencer Loat Farquharson (1871–1942) matriculated at University College in 1890. He read Classics and obtained a First both in Mods in 1892 and in Finals in 1894. He then became a Fellow of University College from 1899 until his death in 1942, serving as Dean for many years, and teaching Logic. Nicknamed 'the Farq' or 'Farquhie', he was one of the best-remembered Fellows of his day, enjoying a reputation among the undergraduates for a slight eccentricity, and among the Fellows for his High Table repartee. However, Farquharson was rather more than a mere wag: he helped revise the Greek Lexicon of Liddell and Scott, and he prepared an edition and translation of the *Meditations* of Marcus Aurelius, which was published just after his death. Furthermore, it is said that, in 1923, he was a possible candidate for the Mastership. Farquharson joined the Territorial Army, and rose to the rank of Colonel, a title which he regularly used in civilian life.

Only a few papers of Farquharson are preserved in the College's archives. **UC:S19/C1/1–3** and **UC:S19/P1/1** were transferred to the archives in February 1999 as Accession No. 120; **UC:S19/N1** and **UC:S19/MS1** had originally been deposited in the Library of University College at an unknown date, and were then transferred to the College Archives in February 1996, and **UC:S19/P2/1–2** were found in the archives during the stocktaking of 1993.


