UC:P10 Papers of Philip Cawthorne Fletcher (1882-1961)

Philip Cawthorne Fletcher (1882–1961) came up to University College in 1901 from Rugby, and was awarded a Scholarship. He read Classics, and was awarded a Second in 1905.

In 1908, he became a master at Charterhouse, and remained there until his retirement in 1945. In 1938, he founded a Scholarship to be awarded every other year to Old Carthusians coming up to University College.

Of his papers, **UC:P10/F1–F2**, a collection of consisting of undergraduate bills, were certainly given to the College in 1982. UC:P10/P1/1 was found in a different part of the Archives in the stocktaking of 1993, but were almost certainly given at the same time.

The photographs are the most important part of **UC:P10**; They include photographs of College Societies, most notably the Martlets and the Churchwardens' society, and alongside the formal team photos are some small ones clearly taken by Fletcher himself.
