Nigel Tully came up to University College in 1961 to read Physics. Soon after coming up he formed a pop group called the Fourbeats, which was one of the first pop groups (as opposed to jazz bands) formed in the university. The Fourbeats played regularly at dances and other events in Oxford during Tully's time and afterwards. The group included other members of University College, including Ray Blazdell (matr. 1961)

On going down from Oxford, Tully worked for IBM for many years, whilst continuing to perform with his band. During 1965 the Fourbeats were renamed the Dark Blues, and the Dark Blues still continue successfully as a band, mainly performing at private functions. Tully has also served as Executive Chair of the National Youth Jazz Orchestra, and was awarded the MBE in 2018 for services to music.

Tully gave this collection of posters and other ephemera relating to his time at Oxford, and immediately afterwards, in August 2021 as Accession No. 1511. They comprise a very significant sample of material about dances, balls and other events happening at Oxford in the early 1960s, as well as some programmes for plays, some of which he was involved with as musician or sound engineer.
