

## **Demolition Works Complete and Foundations Work Commencing**

Dear Residents,

I am happy to report that we have completed the demolition of the 115 Banbury Road extensions. We hope this work did not inconvenience you too much. The completion of this demolition means the site is now ready for the new buildings' foundation works to commence and this work will continue over the next few months.

We have also completed the site hoarding, and over the next couple of weeks we will finish painting, as well as putting up some design work telling the Univ North development story.

During May we will install our main site office on the Banbury Road side of the site, and the delivery team will then be able to move onto the site.

At the Staverton Road side of the site, the SDC works remain within the Univ site area, including underground duct installation and pathways to construct the new buildings. As a result of this, there will be increased traffic movement on Staverton Road, which the SDC traffic marshals will manage. Renovation works to the Garden House will follow, and more details of this element of the work will be provided in due course.
