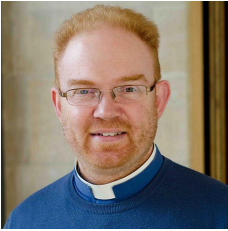

The Revd Dr Patrick Richmond is Vicar of Christ Church, Eaton in Norwich, Chair of the House of Clergy in the Norwich Diocesan Synod, and a member of the General Synod of the Church of England. Before being ordained he read medicine and did a DPhil in physiology at Oxford, worked with drug addicts in Pakistan, and studied theology at Wycliffe Hall. He is chair of the Science and Faith in Norfolk Group.
