



SWIRE SCHOLARSHIP TENABLE AT UNIVERSITY COLLEGE, OXFORD UNIVERSITY 2024-2025

The Swire Scholarship is offering a scholarship for undergraduate students tenable at University College, Oxford. The Scholarship is known as Swire Scholarship and will be awarded annually on a competitive basis under the following conditions:

Tenure

The Scholarship will be tenable for the full duration of the successful applicant's three-year or four-year undergraduate course (depending on the length of the relevant programme of study) at the University College, subject to satisfactory progress.

Value

The award covers the scholar's course fee, plus a maintenance grant (£15,096 per annum at current level). In addition, economy class air fares between The Hong Kong SAR ("HK") and London will be provided to the scholars at the beginning and the end of the period of tenure. It is expected that the scholars will reside in Oxford throughout each academic year, except for short periods of fieldwork which may involve study in another country.

Eligibility

Eligibility for the Scholarship is restricted to permanent residents of HK who have completed the majority of their formal education in HK. Applicants must have the intention of returning to HK after their studies to pursue a career in business, government or in a recognised profession. The successful candidate for the 2024 Scholarship must be in receipt of a conditional or unconditional offer of a place at University College, Oxford, made by the College during the 2023-24 admissions round, for three-year or four-year undergraduate study commencing in October 2024. Subsequent application for migration from any other College to University College will not be accepted.

Please check information on course pre-requisites at Oxford's website www.ox.ac.uk/study. Details of the application procedure for undergraduate admissions and relevant diary dates are available on the same website and must be strictly adhered to.

Other Terms

The successful candidate for the 2024 Scholarship, if awarded, will start his or her studies at University College, Oxford, in October 2024.

An award recipient cannot hold concurrently a Swire Scholarship with any other scholarship.

The scholarship will be awarded by a selection committee whose members will be appointed by The Swire Scholarship. In any year where no candidate is judged to be of sufficient merit, no award will be made.

Important Dates

Application is open until **31 October 2023**.

Applicants who do not hear from us by August 2024 may assume their application is unsuccessful.

1. Please upload to your application form (a) your academic reports for the recent two years and (b) your public examination results.
2. Your referees should send a scanned copy of their reference, showing the letterhead of the school/institute they represent, to swirescholarships@jsshk.com on or before the application deadline. The referees must include the principal and a teacher of the school you are attending currently.
