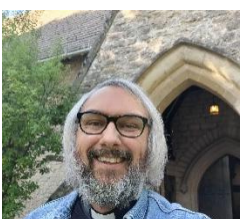
3 May: Choral Evensong and Choir Reunion
The Revd Dr Hester Jones

Hester Jones is Team Rector in the Witney Benefice, in West Oxfordshire, where she has been for just over a year. Before moving to Witney she served as Dean of Chapel at Winchester College, Vicar of Abbots Leigh and Leigh Woods in the Bristol Diocese, and as Curate and Associate Minister in St Mary Redcliffe, Bristol. Hester has a PhD in English from Cambridge and was a lecturer in English at Liverpool University for eleven years, and then a senior Lecturer in Bristol for fifteen. Her research and writing have focused on ways in which poetry across the ages has responded to faith and spiritual exploration.

Mark Nam is the Vicar of St John's, Woodley, and the UK Minority Ethnic Associate Dean for the Diocese of Oxford. He founded The Teahouse in 2021, a network raising the profile and participation of Chinese-heritage communities. He is also a Chaplain for the RAF Cadets. Mark writes and lectures widely, including sermons for The Canterbury Preacher's Companion (Canterbury 2024-27) and a chapter for Chinese Heritage and British Christianity (SCM 2025), and he has contributed to an upcoming volume on artificial intelligence and theology (Bloomsbury 2026). He is a regular contributor to BBC local radio and faith-based media, and a trustee for both SPCK Publishing and the Li Tim-Oi Foundation. Mark was a recipient of the Archbishop of Canterbury's Lambeth Award in 2023, and a National Diversity Awards winner in 2025.
